Outcome

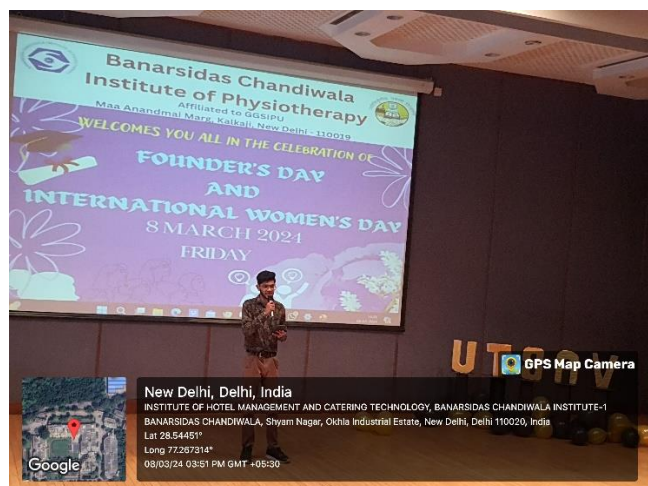
The celebration served as a reminder of the institute's rich heritage, its commitment to academic excellence, and its unwavering support for gender equality and women's empowerment

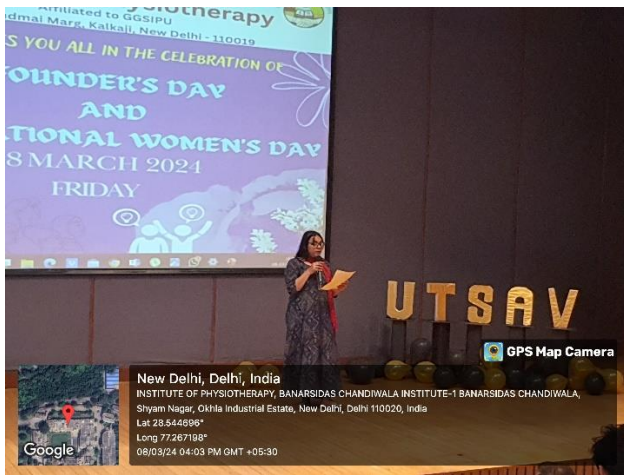
Conclusion
