NEW ADMISSION (AY 2024-2025)

1. Infrastructure Details:

Our institution has air-conditioned, spacious, and well-ventilated classrooms with LCD projector, complemented by a fully equipped library housing over 2500 books in the field of Medical Science and Physiotherapy. Additionally, we have OPD and Labs such as Musculoskeletal Lab, Research Lab, Electrotherapy Lab, Exercise Lab, Sports Lab and Computer Labs which are fully air-conditioned, providing an optimal learning environment for students.

2. What are the eligibility criteria for the BPT/MPT Program?

Eligibility Criteria for **BPT** Program:

- I. Age-17-21 years old
- II. Student should have scored 50 % in XIIth (PCB)
- III. Student must have qualified IPU CET/ CUET exam.

Eligibility Criteria for **MPT** Program:

- I. Students must have qualified BPT with 50%.
- II. Student should have DCPTOT registration
- III. Student must have qualified IPUCET

3. How can I apply for BPT/MPT programs?

You can apply online through the official website of the GGSIP University offering program. The application process includes filling out an application form and submitting the required application fee.

4. What documents are required for the application?

5. Are entrance exams required for BPT/MPT admissions?

Yes, CET of GGSIPU/CUET Exam for BPT/MPT.

6. How many seats are available for BPT and MPT program?

For BPT-60 seats;

For MPT Musculoskeletal- 8 seats;

MPT Sports –5 seats

7. What is the system of education-semester/ annual?

BCIP offers Annual System of Education

8. Is there hostel facility available?

Yes, BCIP has separate Hostel facility for Boys & Girls

9. What Specialisations are there for MPT Programs in BCIP?

Master of Physiotherapy –Musculoskeletal (MPT-MSK),

Master of Physiotherapy–Sports (MPT-SPORTS)

10. How long does a BPT program typically take to complete?

It takes four years and 6 months mandatory Internship to complete BPT Course. So, It's a 4 ½ years Program.

13. Can students pursue further education after completing BPT?

Yes, many students choose to pursue further education after completing their BPT degree. Options include pursuing a Master of Physiotherapy (MPT), specialized master's degrees (such as Musculoskeletal, Neurology, Cardiopulmonary, Sports etc), or professional certifications from India or Abroad.

14. Are scholarships available for students?

Yes.EWS, Merit cum Means, Minority, SC/ST/OBC related scholarship, NSP are available as per Govt rules.Students can apply for the same as per eligibility.

15. Does the college have extracurricular activities?

Yes, we have different Clubs like Entrepreneurship Development Club, Social Media Club, Eco Club, Cultural club, Literary Club to promote extracurricular activities.

16. What are the qualifications of faculty members in BCIP?

We have 13 faculty members with minimum qualification as Masters in Physiotherapy and 2 are Ph.D holders, 5 are pursuing Ph.D.

17. What are available fee payment options?

We have online payment options available. Otherwise DD is accepted. No cash is accepted.

18. What kind of placement assistance does BCIP provide?

BCIP provides comprehensive placement assistance, including resume building, interview preparation, industry interactions, and internship opportunities to enhance students' employability.

19. What is the placement record of BCIP?

BCIP has a 100% placement track record, with a high percentage of students securing placements in reputed Hospitals and companies.

20. Which are the organisations where students generally get placed and on what package?
